

HOW TO PRACTICE OUR MONTHLY SCRIPTURE MEMORIZATION

- 1) *Get the Monthly Scripture Memory page found in the bulletin on the first Sunday of each month. (Additional copies can be found on one of the tables in the Atrium)*
- 2) *Look over the weekly passages to be memorized and the dates in which they are due.*
- 3) *Read the passage to be memorized several times each day.*
- 4) *Choose a family member or a good friend as a Memory Work Assistant to practice saying the passage from memory. This person will initial the Monthly Scripture Memory page in the appropriate place when you have said the required passage from memory by the due date.*
- 5) *Helpful Hint: Create an AID PAGE to help you in your memorizing. This page is done by writing the first letter of each word in a verse side by side on a sheet of paper. Here is an example:*

VERSE: "I am the true vine, and My Father is the vinedresser.

AID PAGE: *I a t t v, a M F i t v*

Do this same thing for all the verses in the passage to be memorized.

- 6) *Practice saying the verse using only your AID PAGE.*
- 7) *Stop using the AID PAGE and say the verse to your Memory Work Assistant without it.*
- 8) *Have your Memory Work Assistant initial the page when you have said the passage from memory. (One help per verse total for the whole passage.)*
- 9) *For younger children, choose one verse from each of the weekly passages for them to say. (Senior members may also choose one verse per week to say if he or she feels he/she just cannot memorize more. This is not preferred but allowed)*
- 10) *As soon as you have memorized that passage by the due date, mark it on the "READ THROUGH THE BIBLE AND SCRIPTURE MEMORY ACCOUNTABILITY CHART in the atrium of the church building as completed.*
- 11) *When you have finished saying all the weekly passages, say the whole passage by the end of the month for full credit .*
