**Scripture Memory: 2 Peter 1:1-4\*\*\***

**Lesson:** The Bible has much more to say about Elohim, but we will continue our study in Genesis 2 later where God has another name. It is a combination of two names, Elohim and Jehovah (Yehovah) translated LORD God. Jehovah is the transliterated German word of the 4 Hebrew letters YHWH. The Hebrew text was not written with vowels, they were put in around 900 AD. Notice, “LORD” is all capitalized. In the OT, Adonai or “Lord” is also used, but we will study that name later. In order to study LORD God, it would be good to understand a little of how Yehovah has revealed Himself. **LORD - Yehovah**, yeh-ho-vaw' - *from 1961*, used 5521 times in the OT, (the) self-Existent or Eternal; Jehovah, Jehovah, the Lord.

Since Exodus 6:3 says that “by my name JEHOVAH was I not known to them,” and they are all said to have used the name, can we remember that Moses is retelling the story of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob and is trying to explain to the Children of Israel that this I AM that he met in Exodus 3 is the God (Elohim) with whom the three talked. Let’s return to Exodus 3 to meet Jehovah.

**I AM** - 1961 Strong's - (see first page) - *hayah, haw-yaw* - to exist, i.e. be or become, come to pass (always emphatic) beacon, be(-come).

10. According to Exodus 3:16-18, what two main things does the LORD want Moses to communicate to the elders of Israel?

Examine verse 16 and read it with, Elohim and Jehovah in it. One can see that God is trying to help all see that Jehovah is Elohim!
