The most high - Elyown - el-yone' - from 5927; lofty, an elevation; ***as title, the Supreme***:--(Most, on) high(-er, -est), upper (-most).

God - 'el, ale - short form of elohim - strength; as adjective, mighty; especially the Almighty (but used also of any deity):-- God (god), great, idol, might(-y one), power, strong.
